Saving Lives Together

80% of cardiac arrests happen at home.

For every minute that effective CPR is delayed the chances of survival go down by 10%.

Our Charity is working to increase public access to defibrillators across the South West, especially in communities experiencing the greatest health inequalities.

What is a Community First Responder (CFR)?

They are 600+ dedicated volunteers who provide emergency assistance to their local communities, ahead of ambulance arrival. They can be on call at any time.

Attending 20,000+ incidents a year, their contributions really do save lives, reduce pain and provide reassurance to people in critical moments.

The NHS provides them with their training and baseline kit. Generally, they respond to calls in their own cars.

Our Charity supports them to fundraise for enhanced kit and dedicated Community Response Vehicles so they can do even more for their communities.
